Our father Mike Fedun passed away at home on February 3, 2017 after a 2 year battle with cancer. Mike was born in Peno, Alberta on May 1, 1928; he was one of 6 children born to Wasil and Anne Fedun. Mike was forced to retire when he was 60 due to a trucking accident which broke his back. It was during this time when his wife Anita passed away from cancer.

Mike spent his retirement travelling and later when he could not travel, enjoyed his time in the North Peace Apartments playing cards with friends and being their number one dancer. Mike also macraméd hangers and everyone that came to visit were gifted a few.
